Arts and Sciences

Montengarde continues to have regular arts and sciences evenings twice a month on the 1st and 3rd Monday evenings. They are hosted by Caterina and sometimes other members.

The culinary group also continues to meet once per month, generally on the arts and sciences evening. The most recent theme for the culinary group was foods from the Silk Road.

Polyphonia continues to meet on Wednesday evenings at Althea and Bjar's home for singing of period songs. They are working on songs for the November Tavern, Yule and 12th Night.

Master Thorvald continues to teach dance at taverns and Althea teaches when he is not present. The Barony is preparing for the up and coming 12th Night event where the new Arts and Sciences champion will be chosen in January. A single entry bardic performance will be held by the newest Montengarde Bardic Champion at 12th Night. There will also be a competition and runway display of garb from the Silk Road with a small prize in each of the categories, beginner, intermediate and advanced depending upon the participation.

The Bardic competition had 3 people vying. Lady Lianora, Arnaut de Najac and Caterina Etcetera. Arnaut de Najac was the winner and has succeeded from Alice Percy. A great big thank you goes out to all those who supported the competition and were excellent audience members during the competition from our late and current Bardic champions.

At Samhain there was a fishbowl sharing with 5 participants who discussed their unfinished projects. There was also a round table discussion hosted by Drifa and attended by members of the Arts and Sciences as well as the Bardic community. Drifa will report on this when she gets back. I strongly suggest that any people that are part of the Arts and Sciences community, even peripherally, should take part in the next discussion that is hosted.

- We discussed having Teaching Circle Talks as a way to share knowledge and foster more of a sense of community in the A&S and Bardic community.
- We discussed how the A&S and Bardic community can support each other because they are strongly related.
- Alternate formats for competitions and championships were also discussed.
- More needs to be discussed and agreed upon in the future as there was not enough time and much good discussion was had.

Family Activities

At Samhain, we had a wonderful children's area. The hall serves as a playschool during the day, so we were able to use a number of those facilities. In general, I think the kids enjoyed themselves. Thanks to all the parents who brought in toys for everyone to use!

Unfortunately, there was one notable issue to report. There was a mild physical altercation between at least two children while neither child's parents nor a designated supervisor were in the room. This altercation resulted in one of the children vomiting on the floor because he was so upset and the parent of another, unrelated child being left to comfort the child and clean it up. This parent did not know the children well, had no contact or medical information for the child, and could not tell me where the parents were. He was not a designated supervisor.

These are families who are known to me and I am now keeping a running tally of incidents. I will be discussing potential consequences for future issues with the Seneschal. I appreciate that it's not desirable to have to sit downstairs all day with your kids during an event, but it is essential that all parents have an established childcare plan before showing up at any SCA event.

I would like to strongly recommend that parents of kids under 14 in Montengarde work together to discuss their childcare needs and potential solutions for these problems. All I'm asking is that your child is with an adult who knows your kid's name, your real name and SCA name, has contact information for you that will work during the event, knows any pertinent medical information, and has the ability to care

for your child's physical well-being while you are doing something else. How that happens is up to you guys.

Unfortunately, I am losing my storage for the Family Activity stuff at the end of November. Currently, it's all in my parents' garage, but they no longer have the space to keep it. I am therefore looking for alternative storage options, perhaps with another council member or some kind soul with a large basement. The items include a child jousting set, a few outside games, pool noodles, hula hoops, books, a wooden castle, and several boxes of craft supplies. If you have a lot of storage space and find yourself regularly bringing toys and other things to events for your kids anyway, I'd sure appreciate your help.
